

Kinton Grange Member Information on using the Grange

Type of use	Member in good standing	Member NOT in good standing
For profit making event	\$150 per day	\$500 per day
For nonprofit event	No charge	\$100 per day

Qualifications for being a Member in Good Standing

1. Kinton Grange dues must be paid up to date. Dues are due Jan 1st of each year, if not paid by the end of Feb the person is no longer a Kinton Grange Member.
2. The person must have been a grange member for 1 full year.
3. The person must attend 75% of the grange meetings. Kinton Grange meets once a month.
4. The person must have participated in at least 2 community service projects held by the Kinton Grange. Community service projects may consist of the following – helping to clean the Kinton Grange, performing some kind of maintenance on the Kinton Grange to keep it operating, or helping with a charity event held by the Kinton Grange.
5. The person must participate in 1 fund raisers for the Kinton Grange (to raise money for operation of the Grange).

Anyone using the grange must comply with the following

1. Work with the Rental Coordinator to book a date.
2. Sign a contract for use of the Kinton Grange. This must be returned to the Rental Coordinator one month prior to use of the hall.
3. Provide a copy of your one million dollar liability insurance for the Kinton Grange. This copy must contain the dates of use, that it is for one million dollars and include the Kinton Grange named as the facility being covered. This must be provided to the Rental Coordinator one month prior to use of the hall.
4. Clean the hall after your use, putting all things back where they were found prior to your use.

Other: All existing contracts will be reviewed prior to their end effective date.
